

### **GMWS Volunteer Driver Agreement**

(Please read and sign below and hand it in to the appropriate office.)

Dear Volunteer Driver,

Thank you very much for offering to drive your vehicle to transport Green Meadow students. Assuring student safety during all school activities is important to us. Therefore, we want to inform you of our rules and insurance regulations regarding student transportation on trips. Please read each of the points below, check each entry to indicate that you have read it and are in agreement/compliance with it, and fill out the information at the bottom.

- \_\_\_1. School personnel and parents who transport students must be at least 21 years of age; all other volunteer drivers must be 25.
- \_\_\_2. An individual's own automobile insurance will always be considered primary coverage. The school's policy will provide coverage for excess damages over and above the individual's insurance limits.
- \_\_\_3. Individuals must provide the school with a copy of their driver's license and a copy of the declarations page of their automobile insurance policy (available by request from your insurance agent) with liability limits of at least \$100,000/\$300,000. High school fax # is 845 356 2921
- \_\_\_4. Vehicles used to transport students must be safe and in good repair.
- \_\_\_5. The use of pickup beds is not permitted for student transportation.
- \_\_\_6. Driver records are public records. I consent to the school checking my driver records from the Department of Motor Vehicles.
- \_\_\_7. Passengers and drivers must wear a mask at all times, regardless of vaccination status, and windows are ajar to enhance air ventilation.
- \_\_\_8. Each student being transported must wear an individual seat belt during travel.
- \_\_\_9. Students must use car seats where appropriate. No student in grade 4 or below may ride in the front seat of a car. Fifth and sixth-grade students may only ride in the front seat with a parent's written permission.
- \_\_\_10. As the driver on a Green Meadow outing, I am the authority figure in the car and have the responsibility to uphold the educational values of the school. To this end, short of seeking emergency road conditions, I agree to provide an environment free of radio, cassette tapes, CDs, TV, video, computers, game boys, or any other electronic devices in my car during the outing.
